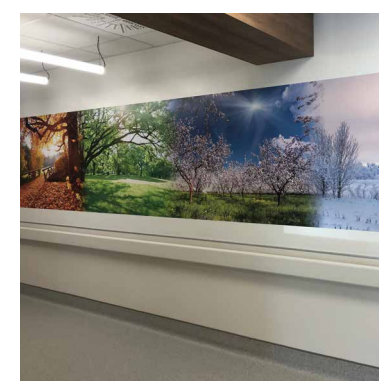
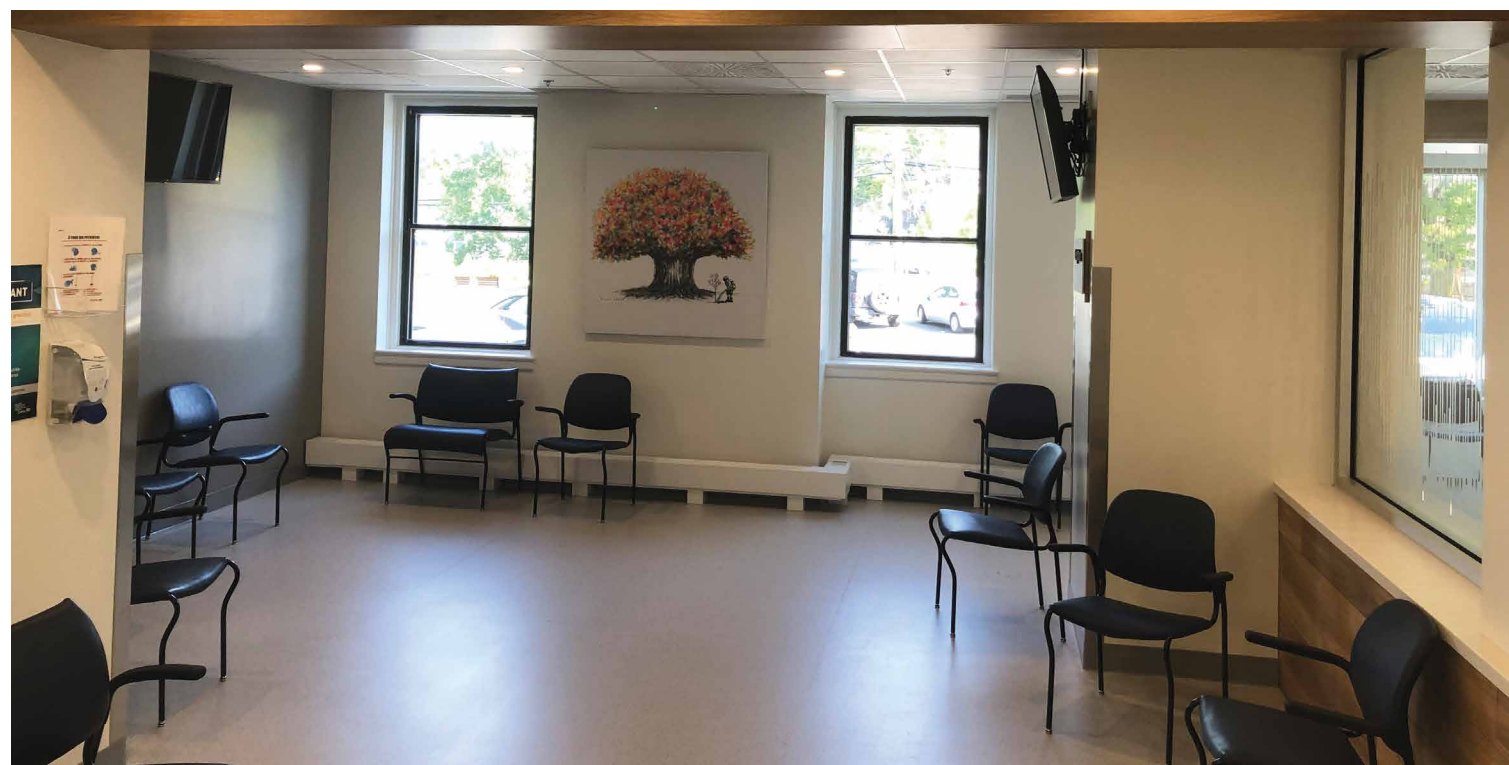
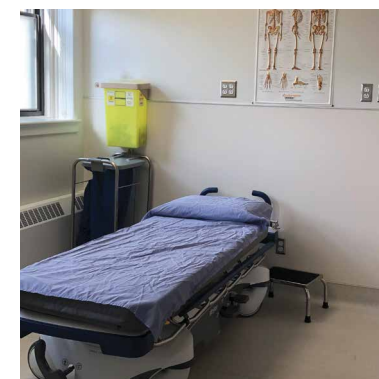
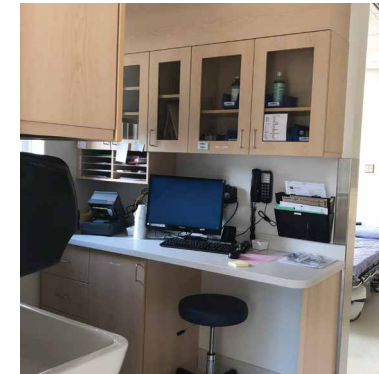
THE BOMBARDIER-BEAUDOIN ORTHOPEDIC CLINIC

The redevelopment of this clinic provides larger and modern spaces for the orthopedic physicians and the clinical team to continue to offer high quality care in an environment better adapted to the needs of patients.

Additional technical facilities such as medical imaging are more easily accessible for this clientele with reduced mobility.

In addition to the new equipment, the surface area of the new premises has been increased from 241 m² to 548 m².

PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT

Thanks to the donors of the 2018-2022 Capital Campaign, the BMP Foundation was able to purchase more than \$1 million in new equipment for the Brome-Missisquoi-Perkins Hospital.



Eight new cardiac monitors for the Emergency Department

To improve the fluidity of the care offered and the rapidity of the management, 8 new cardiac monitors were purchased. Mounted on the wall of each clinical observation cubicle, they are directly and easily accessible. Staff can also monitor results directly from a new central viewing console installed at the nurses' station.

Investment of \$264,096

44 new beds for RLS La Pommerai

The BMP Foundation is pleased to have been able to install 44 state-of-the-art medical beds in the various facilities of La Pommerai: the residential centers of Bedford, Sutton, Cowansville, Farnham and the Brome-Missisquoi-Perkins Hospital.

Investment of \$227,800

New Equipment for the Urology Department

Urologists practicing at the BMP Hospital will be able to work in a state-of-the-art environment using equipment for many common urological procedures such as cystoscopic and ureteroscopic diagnostic examinations (visualization of the bladder, ureter or urinary tract with a camera). Surgeries such as vasectomy, bladder dilation and stone removal will also be facilitated with the new laparoscopy tower and accessories for laser procedures.

Investment of \$195,177

"The purchase of this state-of-the-art equipment, including digital endoscopic instruments, will facilitate the investigation and treatment of patients in need of urological care. Cystoscopies will be more accurate and less painful, and it will be possible to treat urinary stones on site. In addition, prostate resection and bladder tumor techniques will be done with the same instruments I use at CHUM where I still work. This will improve patient care and make it easier to attract a young, full-time urologist to the region." Dr. Luc Valiquette, Urologist



PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT (continuation)



Adult and pediatric rigid ENT endoscopes

With the acquisition of adult and pediatric rigid ENT endoscopes, the BMP Hospital staff can now directly extract foreign body items from the airway and esophagus. By avoiding the need to transfer these patients to other hospitals, treatment can be completed more quickly, increasing the safety of care and improving the quality of the patient experience.

Investment of \$80,227



New Telemetry Units

The BMP Foundation's funding allowed for the purchase of 4 new telemetry units and the upgrade of the monitoring console. These small hand-held transmitters installed on selected patients allow the staff to continue to monitor their heart rate remotely and admit them to a room, freeing up a bed in the emergency observation area. This purchase doubles the number of telemetry units available for the patients.

Investment of \$63,840



Ophthalmic Emergency Room

A significant portion of the visits to the BMP Hospital Emergency Department are related to the visual system. Most of the time, they are related to traumatic contexts that require prompt and effective care. With the help of the BMP Foundation, the CIUSSS de l'Estrie-CHUS was able to equip the Ophthalmic Emergency Room with the latest equipment. This improvement in the quality of ophthalmic care will facilitate the management of patients who had eye-related accidents.

Investment of \$41,070

"The ophthalmologist treats a wide range of eye problems in the emergency department, such as acute glaucoma attacks, work-related eye injuries and neuro-ophthalmologic conditions requiring multidisciplinary care. It is now easier to examine hospitalized patients or patients whose physical situation would not allow an outpatient examination. We are now better equipped to manage these patients quickly!" Storage Cabinet

With this new ventilated storage cabinet, employees will have access to an ideal solution to keep clean and safe flexible endoscopes as well as flexible rhinolaryngoscopes, and flexible bronchoscopes. This type of realization allows to maximize the life duration of each equipment purchased.

Investment of \$24,000

PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT (continuation)



Infusion Pumps for the Operating Room

Also known as Syringe Pumps, these 12 new infusion pumps assist in the administration of intravenous medications and lighten the workload of the respiratory therapy team by automatically injecting the medication at the right time and in the right amount.

Investment of \$34,065

"Thanks to the BMP Foundation, the operating room is now equipped with syringe pumps. These tools are essential to our work and ensure that our patients undergo anesthesia in a safe and comfortable environment. Four anaesthesia medical carts

For the operating room, these medical carts contain everything needed to prepare the patient before surgery or to help with pain management after surgery. The cart is also an additional work surface as well as a safe tool in the treatment of biomedical waste. By allowing the staff to access all the necessary material in one place, it will create less traffic, and contribute to reduce the patients pre-operative stress.

Investment of \$22,000



A New Radiology Reading Console

The arrival of a new radiologist at the BMP Hospital has prompted the need for an additional console to ensure that sufficient work tools are available. This gives each radiologist direct access to patient data without having to wait, reducing delays in obtaining imaging results and improving working conditions for radiologists.

Investment of \$21,394



C-MAC for intubations

The acquisition of this device facilitates and accelerates intubations and treatments of patients requiring respiratory assistance at the ICU. The precision provided by this device reduces the patient's discomfort after the procedure. It is also an excellent training tool for residents who are in the intensive care unit.

Investment of \$19,400

PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT (continuation)

Various investments totaling \$100,740

- A heating cabinet in Endoscopy (to heat blankets for patient comfort during the procedure), BMP Hospital.
- An electric-powered and rotating chair to be used in the shower that respects ergonomic best practices, Sutton Residential Centre.
- Five rolling bases to secure patient transfers while being ergonomic, Farnham Nursing Home and BMP Hospital.
- Five rolling bases to secure safe patient transfers while respecting best practices, Farnham Nursing Home and the BMP Hospital.
- Ten more comfortable and hygienic preventive static mattresses for bedridden patients, Sutton and Cowansville-Larouche ICU.
- Seven self-supporting wheelchairs, Sutton and Bedford residential centers.
- Sixteen wheelchairs, Sutton Residential Centre, CISC de Cowansville-Larouche and BMP Hospital.
- One surgical instrument cart, La Pommeraiie UFGM.

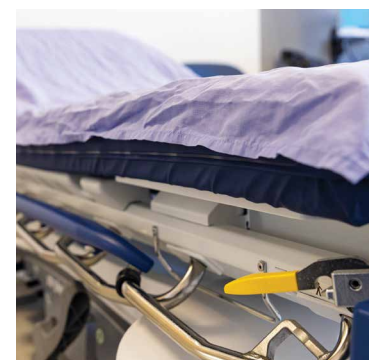
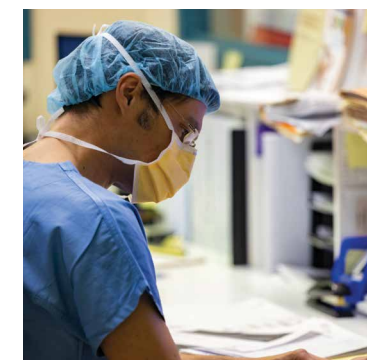

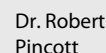


Improved Surgical Rooms

The operating room expansion project is part of the large portfolio of development projects at the CIUSSS de l'Estrie - CHUS that will run from 2021 to 2031. This project must be evaluated according to the growth of the population's needs. For the next few years, improvements to the medical equipment and physical facilities are being planned. These projects will contribute to improve the technology of the operating room and provide more user-friendly facilities for the benefit of the clientele.

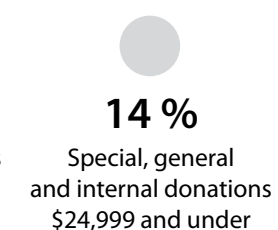
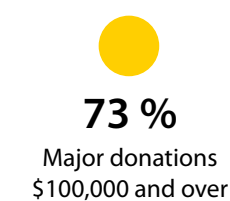
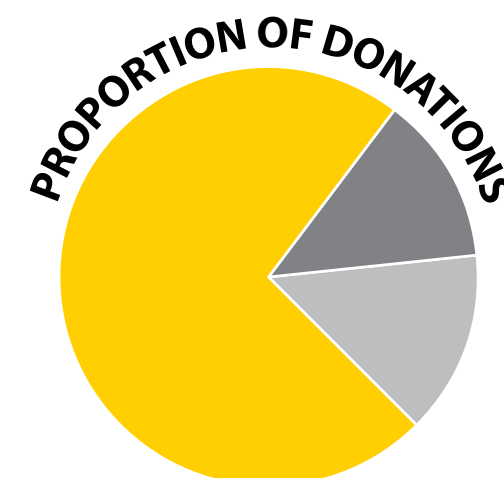
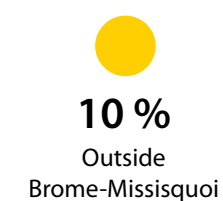
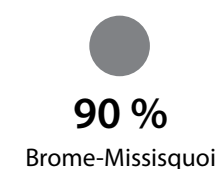
Chart of results
