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








MISSION AND ACHIEVEMENTS

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

2020 Calendar

The arrival of the pandemic forced the cancellation of all planned events. Despite this, the Foundation was able to initiate new activities, while respecting the sanitary measures in effect, to continue to raise funds.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our sponsors and donors for their generous support. It is because of you that we have made progress despite the pandemic!



This year, we were pleased to present the 2020 Award to Mrs Cynthia Clinton, of the BMP Hospital Auxiliary Shop where she has been volunteering her time since 1993. The BMP Foundation is very fortunate to have such a dedicated individual like her! Thank you so much for your continued support to the Auxiliary, the BMP Foundation and your Hospital!



In June 2020, the 33rd BMP Classic was also cancelled due to the pandemic. However, \$13,875 in donations and sponsorships were raised.



In October 2020, the 5th edition of the BMP Oktoberfest was held in a fun and enjoyable takeout format: Bavarian lunch boxes for four people to enjoy in the comfort of your own home. On the menu: sauerkraut, potato salad, pretzels, mini apple cakes and a jug of beer "La Garde-Malade" brewed especially for the BMP Foundation by the West Shefford Brewers. Over More than 400 people attended the event, raising \$22,000.



The BMP Foundation held a "BMP Loto" draw, with tickets available to the general public, and 20 exciting prizes to be won: a CharBroil BBQ and accessories (1st prize), a \$1,000 gift certificate from Club Piscine (2nd and 3rd prizes), a set of gift certificates : \$600 at Rona and \$100 at Fromagerie Gourmande of Bromont (4th and 5th prizes), \$200 gift certificates at METRO (6th to 11th prizes), and finally Au Diable Vert family passes (12th to 20th prizes). The draw for the prizes and the announcement of the winners was held in November 2020. This initiative raised \$12,650 for the Brome-Missisquoi-Perkins Hospital Foundation.



The 31st edition of the Knowlton Golf Club's benefit tournament, scheduled for September 2020, has been changed from a golf tournament to a fundraising day. This change allowed us to raise \$1,500.



In October 2020 was held the 19th edition of the Virtual Walk to Fight Women's Cancers was held whose objective was to raise funds to end women's cancers, recording profits of \$85,000 for this virtual edition. This activity was organized by the Yamaska Valley Optimist Club with the involvement of two honorary co-presidents, Mrs. Louise Penny, a successful novelist, and Dr. Christine Cadrin, gynecologist at the BMP Hospital.

We started the year with two new events, in a series of several, that inspired the community to participate and give to improve health care in our region. A big thank you for this wind of solidarity!

The Brome-Missisquoi-Perkins Hospital Foundation scholarships have two objectives:

- To encourage and assist local students to undertake or pursue college studies in the health care or nursing field, depending on the scholarship awarded;
- To establish and promote a positive relationship between the bursary recipient and the BMP Hospital (CIUSSS de l'Estrie CHUS La Pommeraie) which may eventually result in an offer of employment.



HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

The BMP Foundation is offering a \$500 scholarship to four schools in the Brome-Missisquoi territory to reward the efforts of high-achieving students. The recipients of the 2020 scholarships were: Émilie Poulin (Massey Vanier School in Cowansville French sector), Marie Robichaud (Massey-Vanier School in Cowansville, English sector), Émilie Cloutier and Cloutier and Makayliah Downes (Wilfrid-Léger School in Waterloo) and Zachary Bonneau-Lebleu (Jean-Jacques Bertrand School in Farnham).

CÉGEP SCHOLARSHIPS

Students graduating from high school and enrolling in health care programs at the CEGEP or CRIF can apply for one of the two scholarships offered by the Brome-Missisquoi-Perkins Hospital Foundation. Cégep or CRIF, can apply for one of two scholarships from the Brome-Missisquoi-Perkins Hospital Foundation. These scholarships, in the amount of \$6,000 each (\$2,000 per year for a maximum of three years), are intended to support students in their studies and maximize their academic potential. The nursing scholarship was awarded to Sarah-Maude Pomerleau and the health care scholarship was awarded to Valérie Liechti.

The BMP Foundation gratefully acknowledges the contribution of the Chawkers Foundation for the scholarships and bursaries, to support the next generation of health care professionals. Without the support of organizations that are sensitive to the challenges of tomorrow, this type of project would not be possible.

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP In honor of Ms. Effie Margaret Côté

We are pleased to announce the creation of a new scholarship dedicated to university studies, the Effie Margaret Côté Scholarship. This important bursary of \$10,000 will be awarded in April 2021 to a nursing student or a current health care worker who is continuing his/her education at the university level. A long-time volunteer, Effie Margaret Côté has been involved with the BMP Hospital for over 30 years. Passionate and dedicated to her community, this scholarship is a testament to her continued support of the BMP Hospital and other organizations: volunteer with the Women's Catholic League to provide hot meals to soldiers, the BMP Hospital Auxiliary, the Knowlton Wellness Project, member of the BMP Hospital Board of Directors from 1982 to 1984, recipient of the International Women's Day Award from the Yamaska Valley Optimist Club in 2008 and named BMP Hospital Volunteer of the Year in 2009.



SCHOOL VISITS



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PROJECTS FUNDED

Orthopedic Clinic – \$1.35 million



A remarkable expansion

The BMP Hospital orthopedic clinic needed to expand its premises in order to meet the ever-growing demands and maintain timely access to orthopedic care. Thanks to the BMP Foundation's investment, the size of the department has increased from 241 m² to 548 m². The redevelopment also improved the privacy and comfort of patients receiving orthopedic care. Access to technical facilities related to orthopedics, such as medical imaging, is greatly facilitated for the clientele with reduced mobility. The opening of this new, vast and modern clinic on March 10, 2020, has allowed orthopedic physicians and the clinical team to continue to offer high quality care in a better suited environment for the needs of the patients.

New acquisitions of leading edge of technology equipment

ORL (Oto-Rhino-Laryngology) Endoscope

When patients come to the Emergency Department to have an obstruction removed from their airways, specialists at Brome-Missisquoi-Perkins Hospital can now use a rigid endoscope to extract them. Previously, patients sometimes had to be moved to other hospitals, which diminished the resources available at the BMP Hospital because the specialist had to follow the patient. With this acquisition, we are maximizing staff efficiency for the care of all patients.

Volumetric infusion pumps (syringe pumps)

The increase in respiratory distress and sanitary hygiene measures has greatly complicated the work of respiratory therapists who must sometimes administer several medications simultaneously to the same patient. The use of volumetric pumps automatically administer exact doses of medication at precise times. The Brome-Missisquoi-Perkins Hospital Foundation is pleased to have funded the addition of volumetric pumps to better meet the growing needs and reduce the number of situations who require manual administration of drugs. This helps to reduce the risk of error and also allows staff to look after other tasks.

RRSPs (RRIFs), life annuities and securities
